Shree Swaminarayan Academy is delighted to announce remarkable and noteworthy performance in the Pearson Edexcel International Primary Award, International GCSE, International Advanced Subsidiary (IAS) and International Advanced Level (IAL) results for the May/June 2018 released in August 2018.

The results are the crowning glory to our successful academic year 2017 – 2018 and add sublime glitter to our excellence in sports and co-curricular activities.

Our hearty Congratulations to all the students who achieved their best!

15 candidates appeared for the IAL examinations, and they did us proud with an overall pass of 96.2%!

From a total of 52 entries we yielded a magnificent result of 5A*, 9A, 16B, 13C, 4D and 3E grades.

Accounting, Biology, Chemistry, Economics, English Language, History and Psychology posted 100% passes in the grades A* – E.

The top student was Suryakant Varsani with an outstanding 3A*, 1A, closely followed by Hitesh Varsani with 1A*, 3A.

Other sterling achievements came from Ufayd Khawaja (1A*, 1B, 1C), Danvi Rabadia (2A, 1B), Sarah Tajadin (4B), Krishnkumar Vekariya (1A, 2B, 1C), Ayshah Mithwani (1A, 1B, 2C), Jignesh Vekaria (1A, 1B, 2C) and Fatma Abdulkadir (2B, 1C).

The IAS candidates posted equally remarkable results.

Out of the 115 entries from 32 candidates, there were 30A, 19B, 20C, 13D and 13E grades giving an overall pass of 82.6%.

The top student was Rutik Patel who struck gold with 5A grades!

Among the commendable achievers were Vanshi Patel (3A, 1C), Amisha Laad (3A), Radhika Laxman (3A), Mahima Patel

At the International GCSE Examinations, the academy presented 61 candidates.

Overall, we obtained a commendable result of 91.7% pass which included 38A*, 70A, 113B, 96C, 61D and 58E grades out of a total of 540 entries.

The academy also registered 100% passes in the following subjects: Business Studies, English Language, English Literature, French, Global Citizenship, Gujarati, History, Mathematics and Swahili.

Ankush Halai emerged the top student with a superb result of 8A*3A1B! Darshil Jesani who attained 5A*6A 1B was equally impressive.

We are sure the values they have learnt at the academy will guide them through the journey of life.

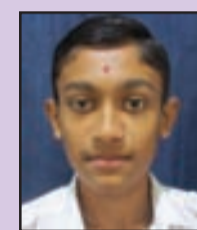
